We are all experiencing the cost of everyday essentials like groceries and bills rising faster than incomes while we recover from the challenges of the recent pandemic. We are here to support young people in our community. This grant provides assistance towards a Child's Christmas.

The Charity has worked hard again, to be able to offer these Christmas grant at £60 per child.

For 2024, the £60 grant per child is paid by bank transfer.

To be eligible for the grant, the child must:

- 1. Be under 16 on the 25th December 2024 and be permanently resident in Orkney
- 2. Be connected to a professional or voluntary organisation who can verify that a grant would make a significant difference to Christmas this year. For example:
- NHS Worker
- Voluntary Sector Agency
- A Social Worker
- A School Teacher
- · Other professional working with the child/family

Please ensure the form is fully and correctly completed, as incomplete forms may result in no payment.
