Term 1 Attendance

As mentioned in the Term 1 newsletter we are closely monitoring pupil attendance across the school and I can now report that overall in Term 1 Orphir had a percentage attendance rate of 94%. In Term 1 there were a fair amount of bugs flying about and where would never want children sent to school unwell please give careful consideration to other reasons for absence (long weekends away, feeling a little tired or under the weather, holidays etc) to ensure your child's individual percentage can remain as high as possible. If a child has an attendance percentage of 90% this equates to half a day off per week, 19 days off per year and over the course of their school career of 13 years mounts up
